CONNECTING TO CAMPUS WI-FI

There are three wireless networks available on campus:

- **DuqNet**: Duquesne University's high-speed, secure wireless network. Sign in using your MultiPass username and password to connect to DuqNet.
- **DuqNet IoT**: Students living on campus can register up to four gaming and streaming devices for use on DuqNet IoT.
- **eduroam**: Is a friend from another university visiting you? If their university participates in eduroam, they can sign into Duquesne's eduroam network using their university email address and password.

BE SAFE IN CYBERSPACE

Be on the lookout for suspicious emails that ask you:

- For personal information
- To click a link
- To open an attachment
- To apply for a part-time job
- For wire transfers
- To purchase gift cards.

Cybercriminals use these messages to trick you into sharing personal information with them that they can use to compromise your account. If you receive a suspicious email, forward it to help@dug.edu.



• **Computer labs**: CTS offers nine campus computer labs, including the recently updated Fisher 435 Learning Lab and Union 112 Collaboration Commons, equipped with printers and core software titles. You can also access a virtual computer lab environment using DOVE (Duquesne Online Virtual Environment).

- **Printing**: Each year, you receive a personal printing balance of \$90 that can be used to print to the public printers located across campus. Use <u>Lab Print</u> to submit a print job from a lab computer or personal device, visit the selected printing station and scan a QR code to release your print job.
- **IT support services**: The IT Service Desk provides technical support to the campus community via <u>phone</u>, <u>email</u>, <u>online chat</u>, and the <u>Duquesne</u> <u>Computer Store</u> offers computer repairs and academic pricing.
